Dosing rules: Inject subcutaneous once per week in the belly fat region. Start at 2.5mg (13 units) and only increase dose after at least two weeks if the medication is not working and not causing serious side effects. If the medication is curbing appetite and you are losing weight, then stay at your current dose as long as its working! The next doses after 2.5mg (13 units) and in order are 5mg (25 units), 7.5mg (38 units), 10mg (50 units), 12.5mg (63 units) and lastly the max dose of 15mg (75 units). Refer to the dosing schedule to see how many units you need in the syringe to arrive at a specific dose. AGAIN, ONLY INCREASE DOSE IF THE MEDICATION IS NOT WORKING.
